Antonio F. Trejo, age 25, passed away on Friday, August 2, 2013.

Tony was born in Oak Park, IL on September 30, 1987. Tony graduated from Grayslake High School then enlisted into the United States Marine Corps where he attained the rank of Corporal. He served with the Crash Fire and Rescue Unit as an Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting Specialist for 3 years and 4 months out of Yuma, AZ. He was a combat veteran of the Afghanistan War and was honorably discharged in 2010. He currently was in the process of relocating to Odessa, Texas where he was employed in the oil industry.

Tony had a huge heart and loved his family immensely. He loved his dog Gatlin, his many reptiles and most importantly the newest and greatest love of his life, his daughter Aria. He loved fishing, motorcycles, his Jeep, sharpshooting, hunting, anything adventurous, 'Merica' and the Corps. Tony always had a smile on his face, a tacky outfit, and a goofy act to follow. We will all miss "Freelove's" sense of humor, outlandish dance moves, crazy stunts, and loud announcements of his arrival.
