Barb Baryl passed away on October 4th, 2021 after a long battle with Lewy Body Dementia. She was 83 years old.

It would be wrong to say that Barb lost her battle because she never stopped fighting. Through her, we know what resilience and perseverance truly look like. Just because she is no longer here, it doesn't mean she lost her fight.

Barb Baryl was born on August 14th, 1938 in Ludington, MI to Theodore and Adeline (Murikes) Sutherland. She spent her childhood in Muskegon, MI. After graduating, Catholic Central High School in Muskegon, MI, Barb moved to Chicago, Illinois where she met her loving husband Dave Baryl. They were married November 25, 1961, and moved to Glenview, Illinois to raise their family. Being avid Chain Of Lakes boaters they decided to move to Lake Villa Illinois in 1977 where they found their dream house in the woods.

Unfortunately, Dave was diagnosed and died of Lung Cancer in 1982 at the age of 46.

Barb entered the workforce after being widowed at a young age. She worked in the Business Office at the College of Lake County for 15 years. She played the role of mother and father in a time when that wasn't common. Despite these struggles, she was an amazing woman and mother who loved spending time with Greg, Jennifer, and Jeff and their families. She loved her friends,
