



## Carol M Reiner

September 25, 1939 - December 27, 2019

On Friday, December 27, 2019, Carol Reiner, a long-time resident of Chicago and Lake Villa, Illinois, passed away at age 80.

Carol was born on September 25, 1939, in Hebron, Wisconsin to Edward and Evelyn (Talbert) Schultz. She traveled weekly from Whitewater, WI to Chicago to attend Michael Reese Hospital School of Nursing and attained her RN degree in 1960. She practiced nursing at Michael Reese Hospital and Children's Memorial Hospital in Chicago. On June 21, 1969, she married Joseph Reiner. They raised three daughters and two sons. Later in 1990, she resumed her nursing career part-time, working at Swedish Covenant Hospital, Chicago, Victory Memorial Hospital, Waukegan, and The Village at Victory Lakes, Lindenhurst.

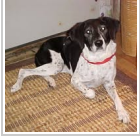
