June 9, 1938 - June 28, 2025

Charles (Charlie) Thomas Quigley, age 87, passed away on Saturday, June 28, 2025. Born on June 9, 1938, in Bronxville, NY, Charlie lived a life devoted to family and service.

He is survived by his beloved wife of 63 years, Angeline "Jean", his children, Susan Suhling (husband Greg), Dr. Michael Quigley (wife Kim), Christine and Brian, and beloved grandchildren Mallory, Ted, Maddie and Marissa

Charlie lived most of his younger years in Mt. Vernon, New York, and graduated from Archbishop Stepinac High School in White Plains, NY in 1957. As a 22-year Navy veteran, Charlie began service with the Navy Reserves while in high school and retired as a Senior Chief Petty Officer. After his Naval career, Charlie went on to receive a diploma from DeVry Institute of Technology, completed his Associate of Science Degree, and obtained his Certificate of Qualification for Adult Education Instructor with California Community Colleges. He continued his service to the Navy for another 18 years as Training Coordinator and then Associate Dean of a Great Lakes Navy Technical School.

Charlie was a long-time active member of Prince of Peace Catholic Church where he served as a member of the Knights of Columbus (4th Degree), Usher, religious education teacher, lector, and Eucharistic Minister. He also was active with the Boy Scouts.

Growing up Charlie was a lone Boston Red Sox fan in a house of Yankee fans. When he moved to Illinois, he transferred his suffering to become a Cubs fan. However, he was able to witness a dream he never thought he would see. He and his oldest son Mike got to attend a Cubs World Series game in 2016!
