Charles J "Swabbie" Heffernan, passed away unexpectedly at home, on April 7, 2017, National Beer Day. He was born to Francis and Muriel (Ryan) Heffernan on February 3, 1938, in Pittsburgh, PA.

Swabbie was a Navy veteran, serving at Glenview Naval Station. He later retired from Illinois Bell (Ameritech) after 36 years. He then delivered flowers for 22 years at Locker's Flowers in McHenry, IL. On December 3, 1998, he married Virginia (Lundblad), who believes he was truly her better half.
