Chuck graduated from Marquette University in Mechanical Engineering at the top of the class and was asked to give the Graduating

Commencement. While at Marquette he was on a 5-year work-study program with International Harvester where he later began his full-time engineering career and ended up being the Vice President of the USA Technical Center for Komatsu America International Company. We had to wing it with the Lord's help and felt we

did a great job. His hobbies were woodworking, astronomy, reading, biking, and many more.

He is also survived by his brothers John(Rita) Tschanz and Tom(Anne) Tschanz and many nieces and nephews.
