Chris began his professional journey as an architect before moving to Lindenhurst in 2002, where he operated a non-medical homecare franchise. He later transitioned to rideshare driving and, through that role, earned a full-tuition scholarship from Uber to Arizona State University. In 2023, Chris and his wife, Mary, graduated together with Bachelor's degrees. With his degree, Chris was aiming to reinvent himself once again, this time as a grant writer.

Chris had a creative spirit and was always eager to learn and try new things. He enjoyed music, traveling, crafting, and had a special love for dogs. He was known for his upbeat outlook, generous heart, and his signature "Chris" jokes that brought smiles to everyone around him.
