



## Daniel C Fehrenbacher

July 23, 1949 - April 29, 2021

Daniel Carl Fehrenbacher, 71, of Antioch, Illinois, passed away on April 29th, 2021, after a short stay at Lake Forest Hospital and JourneyCare Hospice of Barrington.

Dan was born in Waukegan on July 23, 1949 to Carl and Doris Fehrenbacher of Long Lake. He lived his entire life in Lake County, attending Gavin Grade School and graduating from Grant Community High School in 1967.
