Evelyn “Evie” Jadrich (nee Schlosser), 67 of Lindenhurst, IL, passed away peacefully at home Monday, April 24, 2023, with her husband and youngest daughter by her side. She was a beloved wife, mother, and grandmother. Evelyn married the love of her life Thomas Jadrich, on April 22, 1978, at St. Anastasia Parish, Waukegan, IL. The couple quietly celebrated their 45th wedding anniversary on April 22, then she passed two days later.
