Genevieve Gibula, 94, of Lindenhurst, IL, passed away at her home on Monday, March 11, 2013.

She was born in Chicago, IL on October 17, 1918 the daughter of the late Szymon and Germania Wegrzyn. She lived in Lindenhurst since 1988, moving from Chicago.
