James Kleczar, 94, of Lindenhurst, IL passed away on Wednesday, June 12, 2013 at Advocate Condell Medical Center in Libertyville, IL.

He was born in Poland on July 22, 1918 and immigrated to the United States in 1959, becoming a U.S. citizen in 1963. He was a tailor by trade and worked at a variety of retailers in the Chicago area. He was a longtime organist and active member at Prince of Peace Catholic Church. He also played organ at Victory Lakes nursing center and other places throughout Chicago. Jim was an avid gardener and winemaker and enjoyed traveling around the United States with his wife Lottie. He was also a longtime member of the Polish National Alliance and the Polish Highlanders Association of North America.

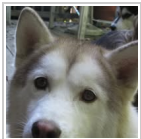
