We are family.

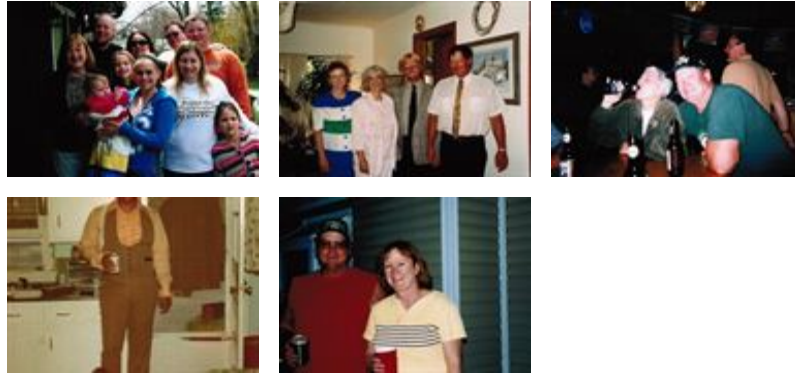
