November 12, 1929 - December 28, 2020

Joan Eileen (Allman) Metzger passed away in the comfort of her home in Lake Villa, Illinois on December 28, 2020. After losing her beloved husband of 64 years in 2019, she stoically managed a number of health issues that come with a long life well-lived. Joan is lovingly honored by her four children, Mary C. (Carl) Pfeiffer of Redding, California, Joseph P. (Jennifer) Metzger of Jacksonville, Florida, Erich F. (Cathi) Metzger of Livermore, California, and Jacqueline A. (Matthew) Bauer, of Chicago, Illinois; and her grandchildren Amanda (Micah) McCrary, Mitchell Metzger, Katherine “Kate” Pfeiffer, Ashley Metzger, Claire Pfeiffer, Thomas Bauer, and Margaret Bauer.

Joan was born in Chicago on November 12, 1929 to Edward and Kathleen (Coan) Allman, and was the youngest of the four Allman sisters, known for their beauty, wit and protective Chicago police officer father. After graduating from Austin High School, she took to the skies in search of adventure as a TWA flight attendant. It was on a flight that she met Joseph Metzger, a handsome young soldier, who convinced her to trade her jet setting life for domestic bliss. The couple started their life together in Miami, Florida, but Joan was drawn to return to her roots and they moved to the Chicago area to build their family, spending 42 years at their beloved farmhouse on Rollins Road in Lake Villa. At “Metzger’s Corner” Joan and Joe proudly watched their children launch into the world, delighted in their grandchildren (and mourned the loss of their cherished grandson, Joseph B. Metzger), and shared many
