Jonathan K. Brisbois of Round Lake died unexpectedly on Saturday, August 31, 2013, from heart-related issues. Jonathan was 41, born July 3, 1972 in Dubuque, Iowa to Frank S. and Mary Kaye (Kennedy) Brisbois (Antioch). He was the beloved husband of Kimberly Cygan and the devoted father of four loving children, Raymond Kennedy, 11, Regina Kaye, 9, John Francis, 6, and Manuel Patrick, 4.
