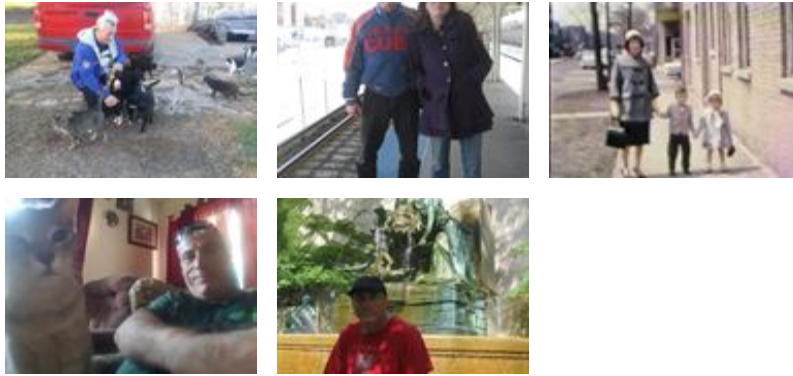

“ I still can't believe Joey is gone... One of my favorite memories was when he was a teenager (not real sure of his age, maybe 14?) and he showed up in Black River Falls on the Greyhound. He told my Dad he was on vacation from school... of course his Uncle Iggy called his Dad and found had run away. We did have fun while it lasted! Played Monopoly, and other games... Joe also spent the summer with us after his Mom died and he helped instill a love of Astronomy in us (he knew constellations and love star gazing), comics (we got a lot of his old ones), old movies (esp. *The Marx Brothers*). He also knew how to get in trouble :D My Mom told me once when he had pulled some escapade she was chasing him and he climbed to the top of the corn crib and yelled "can't get me now!" Boy was he surprised when she climbed up after him....Joe also met his future wife (Janet Clark) on a visit to our farm near Alma Center and they later married in Black River Falls. More recently Joe had surprised and honored us by showing up and lending support at my Dad's funeral. He also surprised me with a ticket to a DEVO concert in Minneapolis and whenever he could brought or sent supplies for our farm kitties. My Mom is going to send a donation in Joe's name to his favorite animal rescue in MN instead of flowers, <http://felinerecue.org/>. I know Joe would approve, he was about to foster another senior cat from them. He loved his three cats and took wonderful care of them and I am so glad his sister is taking them because that would have been his biggest worry. I hope Joe had some idea of how much he was loved.
