February 16, 1924 - February 2, 2013

Julia S. Caban, 88, of Lindenhurst, IL, formerly of Norridge passed away on Saturday, February 2, 2013 at Advocate Condell Medical Center in Libertyville.

She was born on February 16, 1924 in Warsaw Poland, the daughter of the late Stanley and Victoria Kocik.

Julia lived in Norridge, IL for 48 years with her husband Walter, who she married on August 1, 1960. She was a longtime and devout member of St. Eugene Church and said the rosary every day. Julia was a World War II survivor. During the war, she worked with Polish troops as a medical aide. Her father was a Sergeant in the Polish Army and died in Auschwitz. As a result, Julia played a large role in raising her two brothers. Julia's brother was a political prisoner in Poland for two years. During a parade one day, Julia worked her way up to where Polish leader Wladyslaw Gomulka was standing and handed him a letter demanding that her brother be released. Gomulka granted the request within a week. Julia moved to the United States in 1959. She was a very good cook and loved Polish food.

She is survived by her daughter Margaret (Charles) Izban of Lindenhurst; grandson Andrew Izban; brothers Mitch Kocik and John Kocik; and many nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by her husband Walter on December 25, 2009; son Mark; and granddaughter Mary Rose Izban.

Funeral services will begin at 9:15 a.m. on Wednesday, February 6, 2013 at Ringa Funeral Home, 122 S. Milwaukee Ave. (Route 83) Lake Villa, IL 60046 followed by a procession to St. Raphael Catholic Church (Route 173 one mile east of Route 45 in Antioch, IL) for a 10 a.m. Mass. Burial will follow at St. Adalbert Catholic Cemetery in Niles, IL. Visitation will be on Tuesday, February 5, 2013 from 3 – 7 p.m. at the funeral home.
