With a heavy heart we wanted you to know that Keith 'Depp' Depperschmidt, Sr peacefully passed away on the morning of March 6, 2025 at the age of 78.

He was born on October 31, 1946. Keith served in the United States Navy, achieving the rank of Senior Chief Petty Officer. He later served in the Naval Reserves. He graduated from the University of Wisconsin Parkside with a degree in electrical engineering and worked at the Zion Nuclear Power plant from 1975 - 1998. He later worked at the Lake Villa school district from 1999 - 2012. His hobbies included gardening, hunting, fishing, and spending time with his family, especially at his Florida condo. Keith was a hard worker dedicated especially to his wife, children, and grandchildren. He was blessed to live a full life filled with family and friends, especially the last five years since the accident.
