We didn't have a dishwasher at home, so Skinny always washed and I dried. We teased each other a lot, well me mostly. Skinny had our dad wrapped around her little finger. As we washed and dried I would hold a washed plate up to the light to inspect it for any lack of dishwashing. This would make Skinny mad. She would call out "daddy Jim is being obnoxious". Our dad would then make me finish the washing and the drying.

Skinny was a very good storyteller and could sometimes bring tears to your eyes with laughter. She would relate how when in nurses school if a physician came into the room you had to stand and give up your seat. Then after she had her undergraduate nursing degree and a then masters in nursing, she eventually sat across a desk from physicians while she negotiated their compensation. With her telling ability and some embellishments, it was a hilarious story.

Once when we're standing next to a slough, in cold Illinois, we were thinking of buying it. Skinny was able to convince my wife that the frogs that were croaking were really alligator sounds. Carol wanted nothing to do with the slough.

Skinny always wanted to sleep as long as possible on Saturday mornings. Now on a Fall Saturday morning I was in the kitchen with three other guys at 4am. We wanted breakfast, but none of us duck hunters were any good at making bacon, eggs and toast. What to do?

Getting my mother up was out of the question. We had a brilliant answer. One of the guys crawled into the opposite side of the bed with Skinny. She came out of the bed like water squirting from a hose. I assured her that my friend was not getting out of the bed

until she made our breakfast. With her grumbling we ate heartily.

We will dearly miss her.
