He and Robin had planned to move to the mountains where they could walk Tesla and enjoy the beautiful scenery.

Michael's kind and loving nature was an inspiration to those he met. He was compassionate, empathetic, candid and extremely innovative. He was humble in his singing and unaware of how many lives and people he touched and encouraged through the years. His favorite passage of scripture was Psalm 91.
