Patricia C. Cox, 82, of Lindenhurst, IL passed away on Thursday, January 14, 2016.

Pat was born on January 7, 1934 in Blakely, GA, the daughter of the late George and Sallie Correll. She was a 1956 graduate of Grady Memorial Hospital School of Nursing in Atlanta, GA and a 1976 graduate of Barat College where she earned a Bachelor's degree in Economics. Pat married Joseph C. Cox in 1954 and later moved to Illinois in 1967. She had a career in workforce development, working for the Lake County government for 20 years before retiring at age 65.
