June 14, 1976 - March 1, 2022

On the evening of Tuesday, March 1, 2022, Rigoberto (“Rigo”) Ibarra passed away at the age of 45.

Rigo was born June 14, 1976, in Vicente Guerrero, Durango, Mexico to Bernardino and María Concepción Ibarra. Rigo’s early childhood was spent in the neighborhood of Little Village in Chicago. At the age of 12, his family moved to Round Lake Beach, Illinois, and as an adult, he lived in the Lake County area.
