Even though we went to different highschoools we stayed close because of hockey and the bond we formed.

Playing hockey on the same defensive line as him throughout Highschool for the Maulers and the House league Teams were the best times of my life. We probably had a bit too much fun from time to time, but I don't regret it one bit.

I do regret not staying closer to you.

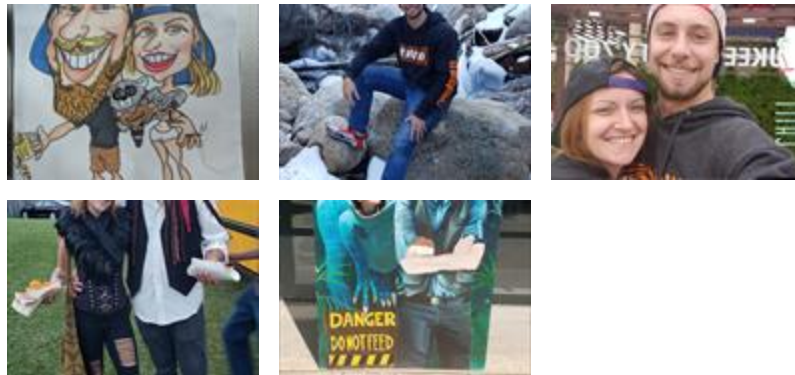
