Sue was formerly an Account Executive with Near North Insurance Agency as well as an active member of the Northbrook Jaycees in her younger years. She grew up in Glenview, IL, and loved hanging out at the Glenview House and attending the Glenview Street Sale with her two daughters back in the

80's. For the last 25 years, Sue and her husband would spend the same two weeks in Puerto Vallarta where they gained strong friendships and made so many amazing memories. Her annual July pool party was always a time she enjoyed reconnecting with friends to catch up on life and reminisce about the past. She had a knack for killing plants and putting things in places that she'd forget. 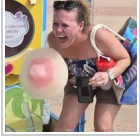

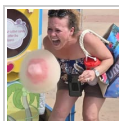
