Susan Elizabeth Miedona of Lindenhurst, Illinois passed away Friday September 6th, following a recent and unexpected cancer diagnosis, surrounded by her loving family.

She was born on August 16th, 1950 in Geneva, Illinois, the daughter of Mathias and Barbara (Schwerdt) Heuertz. She grew up in Wheaton, Illinois, attending St. Francis High School, Class of 1968, and went on to earn her Bachelor's degree from Northern Illinois University in 1972. Sue had a long career of thirty years teaching Art, K-8, at Scott School District 83 before retiring, only to go back a year later for another five years, at Prairie Crossing Charter School before retiring a second time.

Early into her teaching career, Sue met the love of her life, Roger, on a serendipitous blind date set up by mutual friends. They were married on February 28th, 1976 and have spent forty-eight beautiful years together, raising two daughters and then chasing after two grandchildren.

Sue had a great love for flowers, making sure she always had pots of her favorite pansies planted around the house come springtime, and Roger made sure she had a garden of irises and black-eyed susans, among many others, to look at from each window of their home. She loved music and never missed an opportunity to dance at every wedding and around her home, instilling that love in both her daughters. It was common to find a book within her reach, as she loved the peace that came with getting lost in a story. Her special place was Door County, Wisconsin where she took many trips with Roger over the years, visiting the many wineries and all of the local artists shops, from which she would always bring a piece back home to wear or to place around the house as a memento of their time together.

She is survived by her husband Roger, her two children Lizabeth (Mike) Isaacs and Katie (David Ploss) Miedona, and two grandchildren Ryan and Jacob Isaacs.

A celebration of life will be held on September 13th, from 12-2pm at the Ringa Funeral

Home, 122 S. Milwaukee Ave, Lake Villa, Illinois.

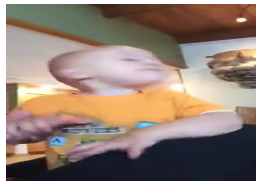
