Marks (Dad to Amelia and Valerie) was known for many hobbies & his bright charisma. He had a constant positive attitude & outlook on life no matter what challenges faced him. He was resilient. He was the ultimate optimist. He was

also known for his humor, and the gift of being able to strike up a conversation with almost anyone. He was a caring and loving husband & dad who would do anything for his 3 girls. He had a successful career and was an inspirational leader through commercial real estate, banking, and running his own business towards the end of his life. As for his hobbies, cooking was one of his main passions, and he was the ultimate perfectionist to improve his recipes to make the best meal possible for family and friends. He also had a love for golfing, visiting Valerie & Amelia at Iowa State, cheering for the Packers & Cowboys, and cleaning his car any moment he had to spare! He was very well loved and that will continue to be his legacy.
