Yvonne liked to keep her hands busy. In addition to commanding the household, Yvonne liked to paint ceramics, crafting miniature flowers for dollhouses & quilting. In her later years, Yvonne had a passion for crocheting pot holders. Her favorite baby shower gift was a homemade baby blanket. She shared her talents with all whom she met.

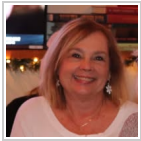
